HOW TO RECOGNIZE AN OVERDOSE


The following are signs and symptoms to look for to identify a potential overdose:




LOSS OF CONSCIOUSNESS, LIMP BODY




SLOWED BREATHING, CHOKING



SMALL, "PINPOINT" PUPILS



PALE, BLUE OR COLD SKIN



SLOWED HEART RATE

HOW TO USE NARCAN NASAL SPRAY:

Before use, check for signs of opioid overdose:

- Will not wake up or respond to your voice or touch
- Breathing is very slow, irregular, or has stopped
- Center part of their eye is very small, sometimes called "pinpoint pupils"

1. Lay the person on their back to receive a dose of NARCAN Nasal Spray.

1. Peel back the package to remove the device. Hold the device with your thumb on the bottom and your index and middle fingers on the sides.
2. Tilt the person's head back and provide support under their neck with your hand. Gently insert the tip of the nozzle into the nostril and pull the plunger back to the bottom of the person's nose.
3. Press the plunger firmly to give the dose of NARCAN Nasal Spray into the person's nose. Remove the NARCAN Nasal Spray from the mouth after giving the dose.


4. Get emergency medical help right away.

5. Watch the person closely. If the person does not respond by walking up or voice or touch, or breathing normally, another dose may be given.



6. Repeat Step 2 every 2 to 3 minutes if available.

7. If additional NARCAN Nasal Sprays are available, repeat step 2 every 2 to 3 minutes until the person responds or emergency medical help is received.

8. Use NARCAN Nasal Spray to provide harm reduction for someone with suspected opioid overdose in public and outdoor. Do not use for use in the home only. Do not remove or heat the NARCAN Nasal Spray until ready to use.
